Diane is a child Holocaust survivor. She was born in Poland and migrated to Australia with her parents in 1948.

An award-winning freelance journalist, she has received the Pluma de Plata from the Government of Mexico, the MBF Award for medical journalism, and the George Munster Award for Independent Journalism.

Diane has written five bestselling books which are published in seven countries. Mosaic, her family memoir, The Voyage of their Life, a true account of the nightmare voyage of a migrant hellship in 1948, and three novels which are based on historical events and explore Jewish identity, Polish-Jewish relations, the impact of Holocaust experiences, and life in post-war Sydney.

Her latest novel, The Collaborator, is set in Australia, Hungary, and Israel. It will be published by Harlequin/HarperCollins next year.
